SYNOPSIS

A FEW BEST MEN (MA15+)

When English lad David announces he is getting married to an Australian, his hapless mates give a whole new meaning to the phrase for better or worse! The chaos-filled wedding day tests their new marriage, challenges Davids relationships with his three best men, and risks turning what should be the best day of their lives into the worst.

ALVIN CHIPWRECKED (2D) (G)

On vacation aboard a luxury cruise ship, Alvin, Simon, Theodore and the Chipettes are up to their usual antics, turning the ship into their personal playground, until they become chipwrecked on a desert island. As Dave Seville frantically searches for his AWOL charges, the Monks and Chipettes do what they do best - sing, dance and wreak havoc. But they're in for a surprise when they embark on an island adventure with their new friend - a castaway whos more than a match for Alvin and the Chipmunks.

CHRONICLE (M)

About three mates who discover a mysterious substance that grants them superpowers. At first they have fun toying around with their new super-abilities. However, things soon take a serious turn when one of the three embraces his darker side.

GIRL WITH THE DRAGON TATT (MA15+)

The first film in the American three-picture adaptation of Stieg Larssons The Millennium Trilogy. Directed by David Fincher (Fight Club, The Social Network). Starring Daniel Craig (Casino Royale) and Rooney Mara (The Social Network), the film is based on the first novel in the trilogy, which altogether have sold 50 million copies in 46 countries and become a worldwide phenomenon.

JOURNEY 2 (3D) (PG)

Some scary scenes
Young adventurer Sean (Josh Hutcherson, Bridge to Terabithia) partners with his new stepfather (Johnson) and stepsister (Vanessa Hudgens, High School Musical) on a mission to find his missing grandfather (Michael Caine, Hairy Brown). Responding to a coded distress signal, Sean thinks his Grandad is lost on an undiscovered island of strange life forms, mountains of gold and deadly volcanoes.

MAN ON A LEDGE (M)

Thriller about an wrongly-accused criminal (Sam Worthington, Avatar) who stands on a high-rise ledge, communicating with a police negotiator (Elizabeth Banks, Catch Me If You Can). Nick (Worthington) was an honest cop who landed in prison for a crime he didnt commit. Desperate, he escapes and hours later stands on a New York City window ledge. Police cordon off the area and agree to Nicks request to speak with police negotiator Lydia (Banks). But Lydia doesnt know that she is part of his grand plan: the staged suicide is a diversion from a huge diamond heist happening somewhere else in the city.

SHERLOCK HOLMES 2 (M)

The seemingly unconnected death of an Indian cotton tycoon, a Chinese opium trader and an American steel entrepreneur has gained global attention, along with bombings in Strasbourg and Vienna. Sherlock Holmes is the only man who identifies the linking cracks shaking the world, with the depraved Professor Moriarty (Fringes Jared Harris) being at the epicentre. The film also brings in Noomi Rapace (from the excellent Millennium trilogy) in her first English-speaking role, and Stephen Fry, playing Sherlocks older, peculiar brother, Mycroft.

STARS WARS EPISODE 1 (3D) (PG)

Mild violence
Join the celebration as Star Wars: Episode I The Phantom Menace 3D returns to theaters. Discover how the epic story of Anakin Skywalker begins on the big screen for the first time ever in 3D. A young slave boy on the desert planet Tatoonie, Anakin is strong in the Force, and an amazing Podracer pilot. Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn discovers Anakin and sees his potential to be a great Jedi Knight. Meanwhile, the droid army of the greedy Trade Federation invades the peaceful planet of Naboo as part of a secret plot by the Sith to gain power. THE DESCENDANTS (M)

From director Alexander Payne (Sideways, Election), a comedy-drama set in Hawaii starring George Clooney as land baron Matt, an indifferent husband and father forced to reevaluate life and face some unsettling truths after his wife suffers a boating accident. The incident launches a personal crisis for Matt which includes strained relations with his two daughters and the bombshell revelation that his wife was cheating on him.

THE IRON LADY (M)

British Prime Minister (from 1979 - 1990) Margaret Thatcher biopic with Meryl Streep playing the titular Iron Lady. Tells Thatchers story via flashback, including the lead-up to Britains controversial involvement in the Falklands War in 1982.

THE MUPPET MOVIE (G)

The Muppets make their long awaited return to the big screen. Starring and co-written by Jason Segal (Forgetting Sarah Marshall) and featuring music by Flight of the Conchords Bret McKenzie. When a nefarious oil tycoon (Chris Cooper) plans to raze Muppet Theater to drill for oil, uber-fan Gary (Segal) sets out with his girlfriend Mary (Amy Adams) to reunite the disbanded Muppet troupe in order to save it. Features numerous celebrity cameos including Mila Kunis, Zach Galifianakis, Emily Blunt, Jack Black and Ricky Gervais.
